

#### Welcome back!

*It was great to welcome back our children this week after half-term. So many have returned with such a positive attitude to learning and are really starting to immerse themselves in their new topic for the final few weeks of the Summer term. It has been great to see. We are confident that we will see children really step up even more, as they prepare to move into their new year group in a few weeks' time.*



#### Our priorities for the Summer term

*Over the final few weeks, we will be focusing on:*

- **English and Maths 'catch-up' plans** (making sure children finish the year with the key skills and knowledge they need).
- **Transition** (making sure children are supported and ready to move into their new year group).
- **Children's well-being and behaviour** (making sure children feel happy, safe and secure, and that behaviour choices demonstrate they are ready for the next year group).
- **Increasing opportunities for sport and exercise** to support children's health and well-being.
- **Outdoor learning** (creating Mayfield Magic Moments, where children can apply knowledge and skills in different situations).
