School Improvement priorities









Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents, Carers, Children and Members of the Mayfield

Each year we focus on a small number of school improvement priorities, looking at how we can make the quality of education for our children even better and to help more children achieve and at least meet expectations for their year group across the curriculum.

This year's priorities are:

- (1). Improve pupil outcomes across the curriculum by helping children to: a). know and remember more, b). use their phonics within Reading and Writing, c). read longer texts fluently, d). strengthen arithmetic skills and understanding of number, e). build extra challenge and independence, and f). improve children's handwriting and use of different sentence types.
- (2). Continue to develop the curriculum to meet the range of diverse needs across school.
- (3). Continue to secure good attendance and tackle persistent absence (10% or more sessions missed).
- (4). Continue to ensure high-quality behaviour and attitudes to learning.




