
At Mayfield we talk to our children about the value 'Voice' and how it is important to recognise that everyone has the right to have a voice.

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## Reading

Last week in the newsletter, we talked about the importance of Reading. We encouraged families to try to find time to read with their children every single day, and talk about what they have read, even for just a few minutes. It makes such a significant difference, and if children are not confident readers, they cannot access or enjoy the full curriculum.

At Mayfield, we are having a huge push this year on Reading, to make sure that children have the fluency, stamina, comprehension, and enjoyment of Reading they need.

#### **Reading across the Curriculum**

This year, we have asked every subject leader to really think carefully about how they can promote Reading skills and enjoyment within their subjects.

Reading opens doors to the wider curriculum, whether it's History, Science, Maths, Geography, Music, Design Technology, etc.

Children in History need to be able to retrieve historical facts when researching.

Children in Design Technology may need to read and understand the language and sequence in instructions.

Children in Maths need to be able to read mathematical word problems.





#### **Reading across school**

This year we have really tried to engage children in books and promote a love of reading, whether that is fiction, non-fiction, or poetry.

We have set up some Reading displays to interest our children, linked to different subjects across the curriculum.
