Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents, Carers, Children and Members of the Mayfield Community,

It's that time of the half-term where Miss Sidlow, our PSHRE lead, introduces the new British Value theme to our children.

This half-term is 'Mutual Respect'.

As part of the coverage of this value, Miss Sidlow planned a special 'Diversity Day'.

Classes also took part in some special 'First Aid Champions' learning, provided by the British Red Cross.

We also recapped some of the previous British Values covered – Democracy and Tolerance.

First Aid skills developed today, in an age-appropriate way, include:

- (Yr1) Why is first aid important? (Asthma)
- (Yr2) Meet the characters. (Burns)
- (Yr3) Giving first aid. (Bleeding)
- (Yr4) Introduction to the Red Cross. (Head injuries)
- (Yr5) First aid. (Broken bones and choking)
- (Yr6) Giving first aid (Breathing)
