Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents, Carers, Children and Members of the Mayfield Community,

At Mayfield, we follow the principles of educationalist, Professor Barak Rosenshine, when supporting children's learning and their ability to know and remember more. These principles are:

(1). We review previous learning at the start of lessons.

(2). We present new learning in small steps.

(3). We ask lots of effective questions.

(4). We provide lots of examples.

(5). We help children practice lots of their own examples.

(6). We check children's understanding.

(7). We aim for children to feel success, as well as have challenge needed.

(8). We scaffold and support learning.

(9). We encourage independent practice.

(10). We have weekly and monthly reviews of learning.

These principles are used in each year group and across the curriculum.

At Mayfield we talk to our children about the value 'Pride'.


We want children to feel proud of themselves and of others. It is important that all children get to feel a sense of pride, and the buzz it can create inside.

After learning about the artist Faith Ringgold, Year Three have now been creating and designing their own Story Quilts.


