### Headteacher's Message

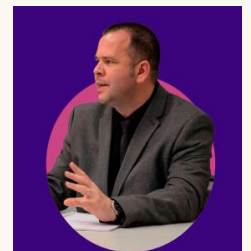

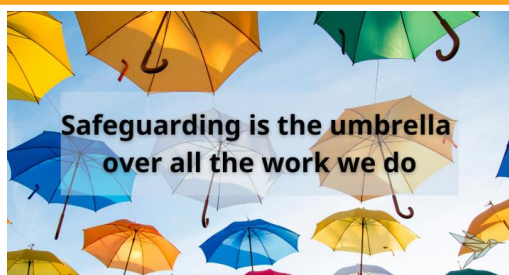

The foodbank is currently really short of the following items: cordial, packets of instant rice, Pot Noodles, biscuits, washing powder and detergents.

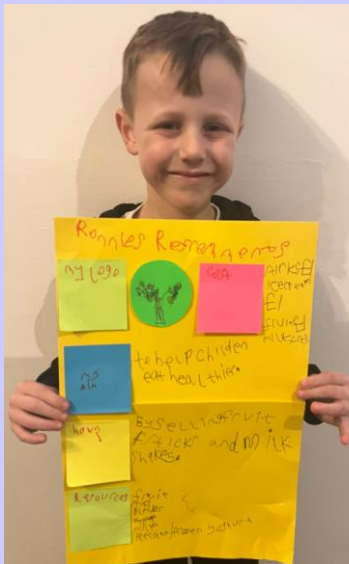
