### Headteacher's Message

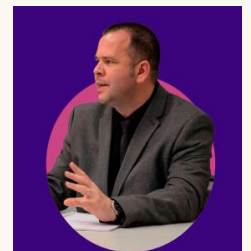

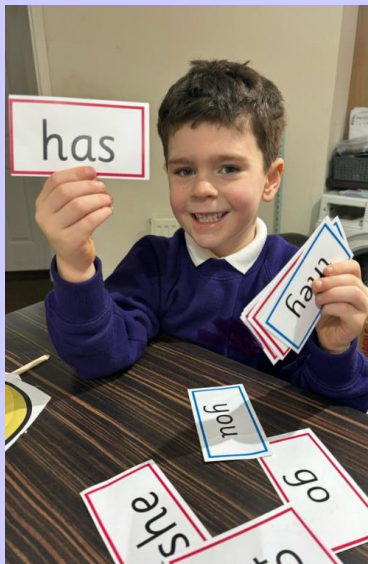


Photography Club

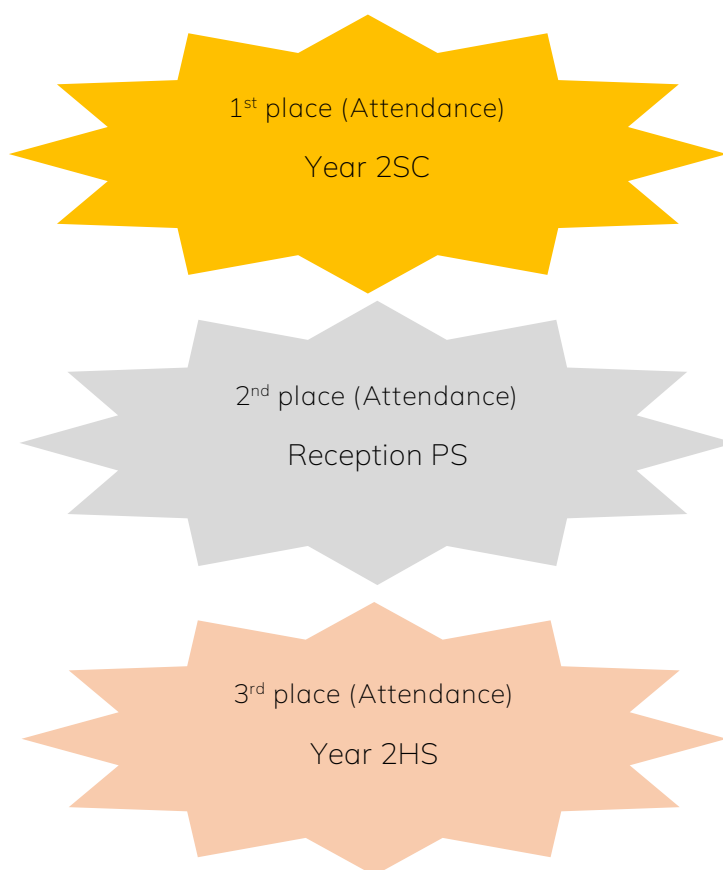

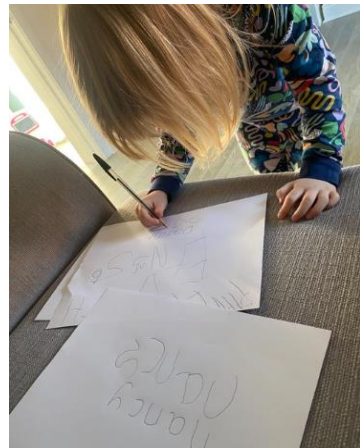
