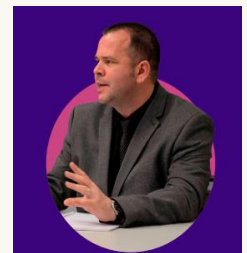
These assessments are an important benchmark, although we recognise that they are a snapshot of the whole progress our children have made over the year.
